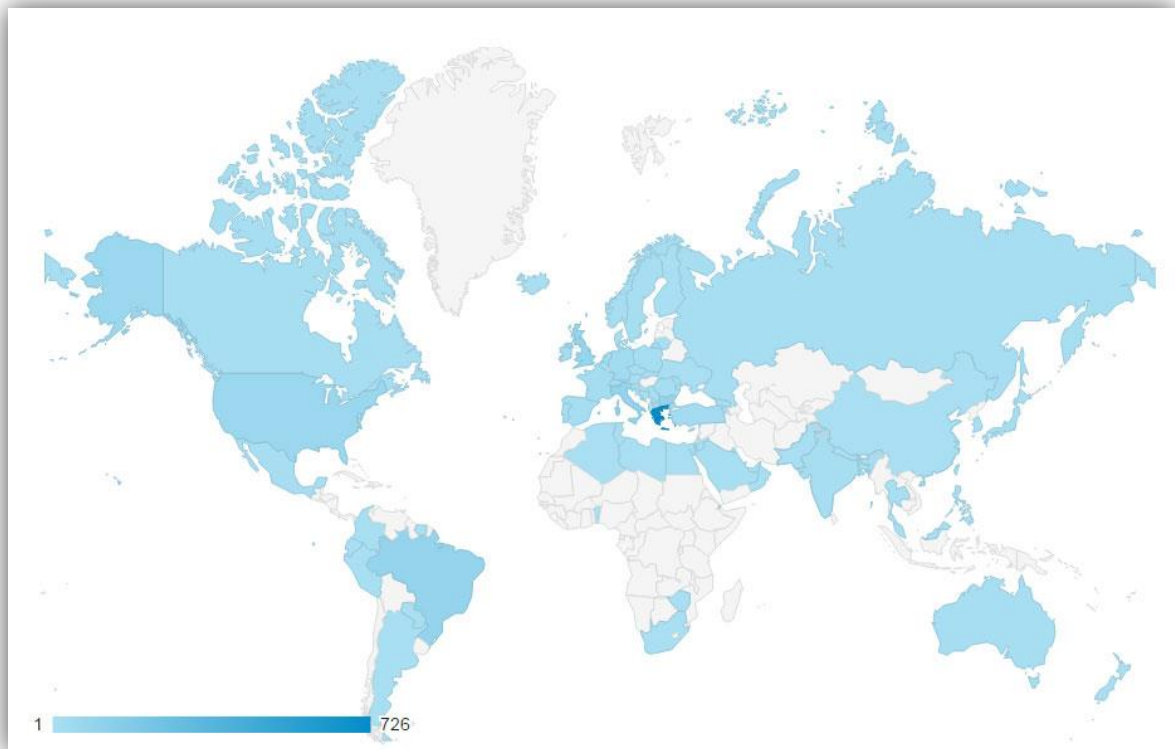
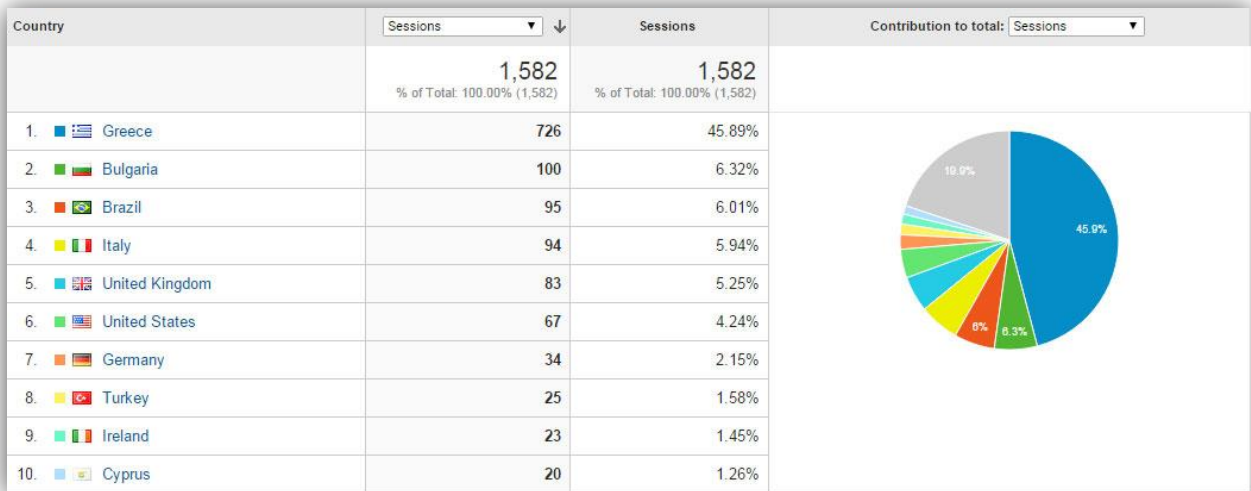


CAA GR 2015 Annual REPORT

- Annual General Meeting on Wednesday, 1st April 2015, during the CAA International Conference at the University of Sienna. Sixteen CAA-GR members were present. Three non-members attended the meeting. Constitutions changes were discussed. Among them was the acceptance of e-voting for the election of the board (The constitution of CAA-GR, V, 4).

- Elections of two new CAA GR Board members, Marcos Katsianis and Tuna Kalayci, (after the end of the term of Angeliki Chrysanthi kai Lena Kotoula). The new members have started actively to be involved in the various topics of the Society.
- Renewal of the membership was also requested from the existing archives of the section in order to update our files and have an updated list of the interested parties.
- Evaluation of the bid for the organization of the next CAA GR conference by the Department of History and Archaeology of the University of Athens (probably the next conference will take place in December 2016). Discussions are still in process to finalize the bid and the details of the organization of the conference. Technical support will be provided by GeoSat ReSeArch Lab of IMS-FORTH. Utilization of the previous WEB platform will be made.
- A workshop / Special Session on “Remote Sensing and GIS for Archaeology and Cultural Heritage” was organized by Dr. Axel Posluchny and Dr. Apostolos Sarris, during the 3rd International Conference on Remote Sensing and GeoInformation of environment (16-19 March 2015, Paphos, Cyprus).
