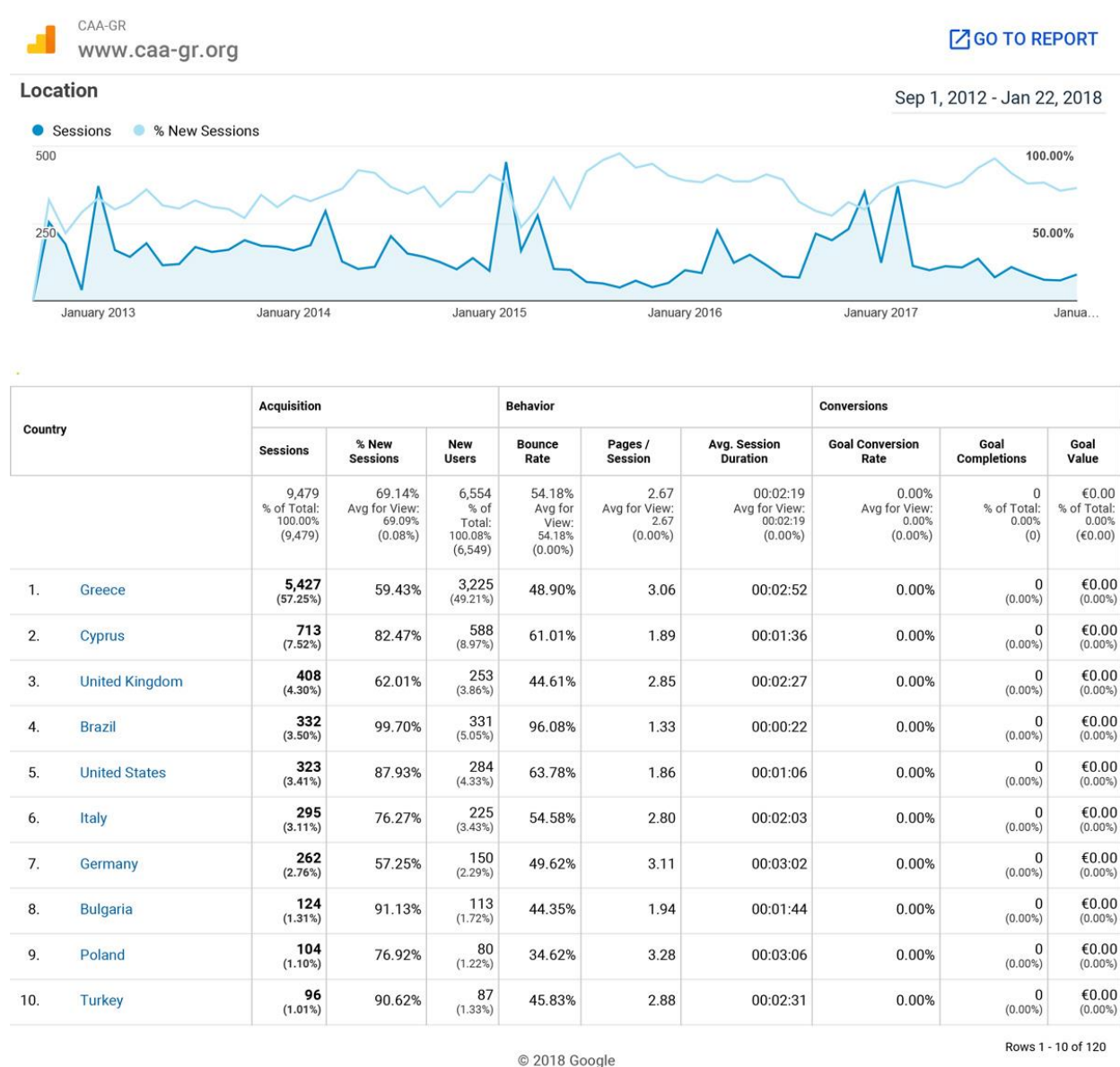


CAA GR 2017 Annual REPORT

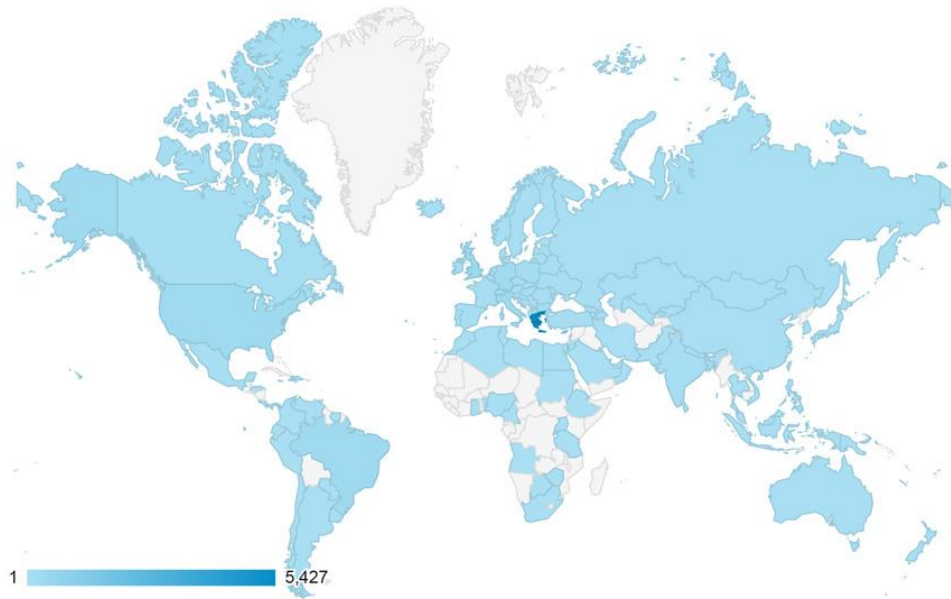


Location
