## **CAA Germany 2016 Annual Report**

The main activity of CAA Germany is the organisation of workshops and sessions at conferences to allow CAA members and other persons interested in computer applications and quantitative methods in archaeology to exchange ideas and experiences.

## **Annual Workshop**

About 110 people attended the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Workshop of CAA Germany on February 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The workshop was hosted by HafenCity University, Hamburg. The conference programme consisted of 15 talks and a poster session with eight posters. After the talks, three software tutorials were offered on statistics with R, 3D GIS and image-based 3D modelling. A social dinner in a traditional restaurant at Hamburg harbour completed the programme.

The upcoming 8<sup>th</sup> annual workshop is scheduled for February 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and will be hosted by the Interdisciplinary Center for Scientific Computing at the University of Heidelberg.

## Joint Chapter Meeting with CAA NL/FL

On November 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Ghent University hosted the 4<sup>th</sup> Joint Chapter Meeting of CAA Netherlands/Flanders and CAA Germany. The conference comprised four sessions with 23 papers plus a LiDAR tutorial. Further information is available in the year report of CAA NL/FL.

## **Additional Activities**

In 2016 our efforts to establish an online publication platform for papers, posters and tutorials presented at CAA Germany meetings made slow progress. The proceedings of the 2013 annual meeting in Berlin were published by TOPOI. The volume was edited by Undine Lieberwirth and Irmela Herzog and is available for free download at <a href="https://www.edition-topoi.org/books/details/1034">www.edition-topoi.org/books/details/1034</a>.

To assist the steering committee in the organisation of meetings, the setup of the publication platform, website maintenance and other activities, we established an advisory committee of currently seven members. Their ideas and support are much appreciated.

At the end of 2016, CAA Germany had 182 members, a plus of 26 compared to 2015. Currently, CAA Germany does not charge membership fees.
