Update on the National Chapter Activities:

General focus of the Czechia-Slovakia National Chapter:

The activities carried out by the Czechia-Slovakia National Chapter are closely related to the focus of the general statutes of the CAA. The main activities include:

- Organising the annual national CAA conference in the Czech Republic or Slovakia (once a year)

- Creating a network of experts on digital archaeology at both academic and commercial levels

- Continuous monitoring and contact with archaeology departments to inquire about their courses and possible involvement by members of the Czechia-Slovakia National Chapter

- Organization of professional workshops and lectures based on digital archaeology (especially for students)

Activities of the National Chapter Czechia-Slovakia in 2023

As part of the activities of the National Chapter Czechia-Slovakia, we have resumed the working activity of the section after the sudden death of its previous formal chairman – prof. Ladislav Šmejda at the end of the year 2022. In May 2023, a new composition of the committee was elected at the CAA local conference.

The minutes of 2023 Czechia-Slovakia National Chapter annual meeting and conference

The 22nd conference was held in Boží Dar, West Bohemia, on 31.5.-2.6.2023 and it was organised by the Department of Archaeology of University of West Bohemia, National Heritage Institute -Regional Office in Loket, Institute of Archaeology and Museology of Masaryk University in Brno and Institute of Archaeology of the Czech Academy of Sciences Prague. The conference was dedicated to the memory of Ladislav Šmejda who passed away in autumn 2022. Ladislav Šmejda was a long-standing chair of CAA CS and a prominent member of our community. He will be deeply missed.

The papers were divided into 5 session and were accompanied by a poster session and a keynote lecture from Sara Polak on archaeology and technology, namely artificial intelligence, blockchain and virtual/augmented reality.

During the conference, on 31 May 2023, the annual general meeting (AGM) of CAA Czechia/Slovakia took place with the main goal to establish new members of the steering committee as defined in the <u>constitution of CAA CS</u>. After the sad passing of Ladislav Šmejda, the previous chair, the position was temporarily covered by David Novák who acted as a provisional chair. The 34 attendees voted and unanimously elected 6 convenors who represent both countries (CZ, SK).

The newly elected steering committee discussed the basic organisation of CAA CS as well as future activities, namely:

1. The committee will inform the members of CAA CS about the activities of CAA annually as a part of the conference. We will continue to support the organisation of the conference especially with regard to the inclusion of students (keeping the conference affordable, promoting active participation among the students, etc.).

2. The committee discussed the option of engaging in organising the CAA conference in the future (say, in 2026 or later) in Prague.

3. The communication channels, e.g. a mailing list, between the committee and members of CAA CS should be set up and maintained.
